Since 2002, each member is audited by the independent Ecocert SAS agency on their vineyard and cellar practice. Exhibiting producers at the tasting include: Domaine Trapet Père et Fils, Domaine Josp Meyer, Domaine Zind-Humbrecht, Domaine Cazes and Maison Chapoutier. Olivier Humbrecht MW, president of the SIVCBD, said: "A vineyard is a living organism and the working practices of our members respect and emanate from this principle, as we believe this is the way to produce the best quality wines from any terroir. We know the word "biodynamics" often sparks heated discussions, which is why we've decided to host this tasting and let our wines speak for themselves."
